

"NY-based flutist Gina Izzo, "Rattles speakers and expectations with stop-time razzle, vocal (flute-talk) and electronic (phaser) effects" (NYC Jazz Record). Izzo has been featured at Duke Performances with Steve Coleman and Natal Eclipse, Lincoln Center Out of Doors with Revive Music, at The Jazz Standard as part of Ambrose Akinmusire's 'Imagined Savior', and at John Zorn's The Stone.

She has performed at Carnegie Hall, Lincoln Center, Jazz at Lincoln Center, David Geffen Hall, The Public Theater, the Jazz Standard, National Sawdust, Bang on a Can Festival, among others, and with artists such as Gabriel Garzón-Montano, Doe Paoro, Beccs, and on an episode "SLAPP Suits" with John Oliver on HBO.

Izzo co-founded *bespoken*, alongside Eunbi Kim, a mentorship program for women in music, and RighteousGIRLS, with pianist Erika Dohi, whose album *gathering blue* has been hailed by *Downbeat* as "one of the most adventurous new music debut albums in recent years."
